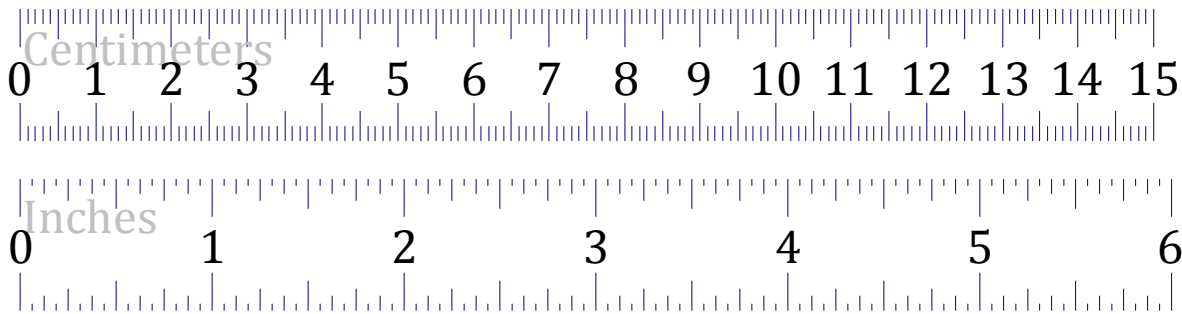


# Convertir Pulgadas y Centímetros (E)
